1. Brick Bash Planning

- Saturday, April 18 – load in and set up Friday, April 17
- Duane in charge of getting exhibitors/vendors – MichLUG already on board
- Planning meeting – Feb 2, 7pm
- Need planning committee - publicity, concessions, volunteers, facilities, hospitality, ticket sales
- Steph – send email to explain Brick Bash for new families, get committee sign ups
- Discussion – new venue for movie (auditorium not available) – black box? hallway?; donations for exhibitors – gas cards, coffee shop/Panera card; look into band min-figs to sell

2. Fundraising

- a. Christmas Tree Pickup – Steph reported that the event was a great success - picked up over 280 trees, estimated donations \$6500-\$7000; will need new committee members from theatre next year; received several cancellations – Huron HS providing same service this year

- No spring concert this year
- Band will participate in VPAA banquet this year
- Symphony band trip – working on narrowing down to 2 international and 2 national choices; will post sample itinerary and costs online for families to vote
- Band display case items removed and case taken over by athletic team; Jason will talk to athletic director about getting our space back

4. Treasury Report

- Tamara & Maggie need to meet to go over budget and then meet with Jason
- Discussion – Scrip as effective fundraiser – time vs revenue; importance of budget to show bottom line so we know how much money is available to spend on band needs

5. Uniform Report

- Kathy has spreadsheet with uniforms from band and orchestra – trying to reconcile uniforms borrowed by orchestra
- All concert uniforms have been distributed to students
- Closets need reorganized to fit marching band raincoats
- 10 garment bags borrowed by orchestra and/or choir – we need them for our students due to increase in number of band students
- Need to order smaller bibbers, medium marching band hats; it was suggested that Kathy put together a wish list; uniform budget needed; should order by March 1 to ensure delivery before end of school year
